15th Annual At-Home Dad's Convention

For those able to arrive early, there will be a special **Dad's Night Out** at Spencer's, a mouth-watering steakhouse just across the street from the Courtyard By Marriott (the official Convention Hotel) on Thursday night, September 30, a **Community Service Project** at the Stephen Center for Women at 27th & Q where the at-home dads will paint and do some much needed maintenance on Friday, October 1 from 9am-12noon, and the ever-popular **Meet & Greet** Friday night at the Courtyard By Marriott where the at-home dads will have a beer and some appetizers as they meet new friends and get re-acquainted with old ones made during past conventions.

Every At-Home Dad's Convention for the last 14 years have provided the men who have attended them the confidence to return home and be better fathers, husbands and at-home parents. This celebratory 15th year promises to offer that again while also encouraging these at-home dads to build a strong support network so they can thrive in their role.
